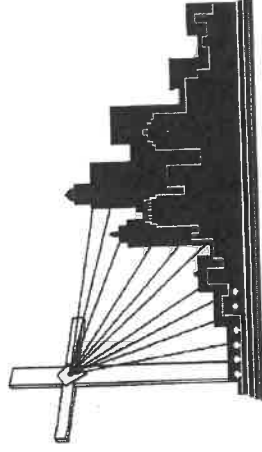


Our Mission Statement:
