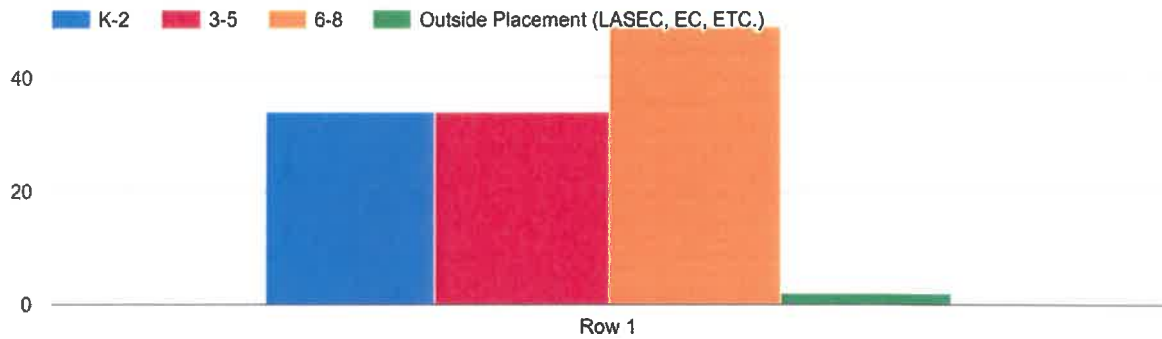


Parent/Guardian 3rd Quarter School Survey Results 11/23/2020

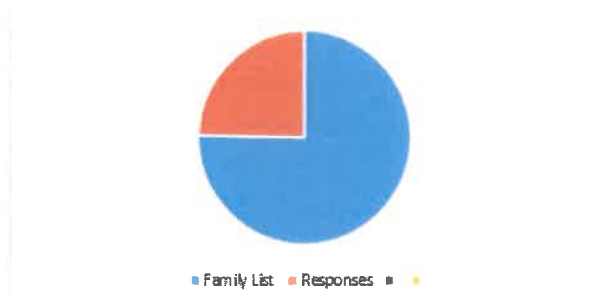
What grade (s) is your child (ren) attending?



What is your first Choice for 3rd Quarter?

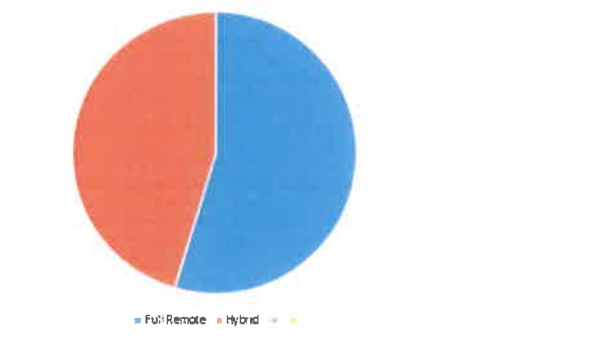
